**STUDENT PLEASE KEEP THIS INFORMATION SHEET**

Below is a brief description of college assistance programs that the Delaware Nation will provide to tribal members enrolled as full time students at a college/university. Please be informed that these programs only have limited funding each semester. Your request will be based on the information you submitted with Higher Education application. Priority will be based on classification status (Sr., Jr., sophomore, freshmen)

### College Financial Assistance

The program's main focus will be to offer extra financial support to college students for what is deemed necessary for the student to reach their academic goal while attending college. The applicant must possess at least a 2.0 GPA in order to participate in this program. Receipts are to be submitted at the end of the semester.

### Pell Ineligible Incentive Program (PIIP)

This program is available to students that are Pell ineligible. The Financial Needs Analysis Form (page 3 of the Higher Education Application) that is completed by the Financial Aid Office must state that the student will not be eligible for a Federal Pell Grant. Therefore, the student will be considered to receive an additional \$1000/\$1500 per semester to defray educational costs. Individuals will be selected to receive assistance on the overall highest GPA among the other Pell Ineligible Incentive Program participants.

### Lenape Wik-a-wam Program (Rental Assistance)

This program will provide rental/mortgage assistance to full time Higher Education/Vocational students that reside within the general area of the College/University they will be attending. A copy of the student's rental agreement must be submitted and a copy of utility bill showing proof of residence.

### Lenape Wise Program

The Lenape Wise Program is for individuals that have completely exhausted the 10-semester/150 college credit hours of the Delaware Nation Higher Education Grant Program. Priority will be given to students that are displaced homemakers or if student had to drop out of college to raise a family. A letter of recommendation from a professor is required. Receipts are to be submitted at the end of the semester.

- College Financial Assistance (CFA) PRINT NAME \_\_\_\_\_
  - ◆ The student must show a need for extra funding.
    - Transportation & food expenses
    - School fees
    - Book expense
  - ◆ The student must submit receipts at the end of each semester. Receipts must be taped onto a sheet of paper with grand totals on each sheet of paper. The receipts will be mailed back to the student if they are not taped onto paper.
  - ◆ All receipts submitted have to be school related. If the receipts are not submitted at the end of the semester the student will be ineligible for this program for the following semester.
- Pell Ineligible Incentive Program (PIIP) PRINT NAME \_\_\_\_\_
  - ◆ This program is for students that are ineligible for a federal pell grant. The Financial Needs Analysis (page 3 in the Higher Education Application) must state the student is pell ineligible. Pell ineligible students will still receive \$400 from the Higher Education Grant Program.
- Lenape Wik-A-Wam (Rental Assistance) PRINT NAME \_\_\_\_\_
  - ◆ This rental assistance program is for enrolled Delaware college students. This program is designed to assist college/vocational students. This program is on a first come first serve basis and/or upon availability of funds.
  - ◆ Must submit a copy of rental agreement or a letter from the landlord stating the amount of rent. The landlord's contact information should be stated in the letter.
  - ◆ Copy of utility bill to show proof of residence.
- Lenape Wise Program PRINT NAME \_\_\_\_\_
  - ◆ The Lenape Wise Program is available to students that have completely exhausted the 10 semesters/150 college credit hours from the Delaware Nation Higher Education Grant Program. Priority will be given to students that are displaced homemakers or if the student had to drop out of college to raise a family.
  - ◆ A letter of recommendation from a professor is required.
