DELAWARE NATION HOLDS RIBBON CUTTING CEREMONY

[Anadarko, OK] – The Delaware Nation is pleased to announce the completion of construction work on the Highway 281 Improvement Project. The Delaware Nation will celebrate this accomplishment by holding a ribbon cutting ceremony on Tuesday, July 14, at 2:00 p.m. We invite the community to join us at the project site 2 ½ miles North of Anadarko on Highway 281.

Sponsored by the Delaware Nation, construction began in 2008 by the Economic Development department. The goal of the project was to improve the existing highway by adding a turn lane and extending the right and left shoulders. This completion of this project has made Highway 281 a much less dangerous highway. Due to heavy turning traffic, accidents were a frequent occurrence. There was a dire need for traffic calming at this specific location on Highway 281. The widening of the highway and addition of turn lanes will greatly improve traffic flow.

“This project is part of our continuous plan to protect the citizens of Anadarko.” Delaware Nation President Kerry Holton said. “We hope these improvements will make traveling to the Delaware Nation tribal complex and Gold River Casino less hazardous.
