

AMENDMENT “B”

ARTICLE VII – ELECTIONS

Section 5. Qualification of Candidates. Any citizen of the Nation shall qualify as a candidate for membership on the Executive Committee, or subordinate body by election or appointment, if such person meets the following requirements: (1) is at least twenty-one (21) years of age on the date of the election; (2) has not been previously convicted of a felony in any court of competent jurisdiction; (3) is not delinquently indebted to the Nation; and (4) has established a physical residence within a one hundred (100) mile radius of the Nation’s headquarters for no less than sixty (60) days immediately preceding the day of the election. Elected and appointed leaders ceasing to maintain a physical residence as provided herein shall be immediately removed from office.
